Hannah³ Haacke (George², Johann¹) was born 22 Apr 1838 in Markham Township, York, Ontario. She married **John Jacob Lunau** 24 Apr 1855. He was born 27 Jun 1832 in Markham, York, Ontario and died 29 Feb 1908 in Markham. The couple had two daughters before Hannah's untimely death on 16 Apr 1858 in Markham, just days before her twentieth birthday. She was buried in Quantztown Cemetery in Markham.

Death has again invaded our midst and called home one of the pioneer residents of the township of Markham, John Jacob Lunau died at his home in Mount Joy on Saturday night after a lingering illness from heart trouble. He had been suffering from the disease for more than two years past, therefore the end was not unexpected. During the most of that time he was the victim of agonising pain which was born with remarkable patience.

The funeral was held on Tuesday afternoon and was largely attended, Rev. C.J. Dobson conducted an appropriate and deeply impressive service at the residence, after which interment took place in Elmwood Cemetery.

Mr. Lunau was born in the 4th Concession of the Township of Markham 75 years ago and was the son of the late John Lunau. He was twice married, first to Hannah Haacke and lately to Mary Jane Udell. His second wife survives him. He is also survived by two sons and three daughters. They are Lambert of Mount Albert, and Rev. Austin of Webbwood and the daughters are Mrs. C.A. Brown, Toronto; Mrs. G. McDowell; and Mrs. V.J. Winterstein of Mount Joy. There are besides three surviving brothers. Jonathan and Silas of Unionville, and Joseph of Mount Joy.

Deceased was formerly a member of the Christian denomination but of late years he cast his lot with the Methodists. In politics he was a Liberal. He always took a lively interest in public affairs and never missed an opportunity to vote from the time he was of age. His last vote was recorded for Dr. McLean in the late Centre York bye-election. He was a man of great force of character and very decided in his views. In his business dealings he was strictly honorable and straightforward. His word was as good as his bond. As a farmer he was remarkably successful. At one time he was owner of 500 acres of choice farming land in this district. Shortly after his marriage he started work on a farm in the Township of Scott. From there he moved to the Township of Uxbridge. Then he returned to the 5th of Markham and later he purchased a farm in the 9th of Markham. This was his home up to the time of his retirement when he came to reside in Mount Joy with his daughter Mrs. V.J. Winterstein.

He was born 16 Jun 1836 in York County, Ontario and died 17 Sep 1895. He was the son of John (b 1803) and Susannah Fierheller. John was the son of John (b 1765) and Elizabeth Fierheller. They were married by Minister Jeremiah Fishborn of the Evangelist Lutheran Church in Vaughan. The witness was Henry J. Shoultz. Matilda died 23 Oct 1927 in York, Ontario.

Daniel was a son of Benjamin or Archibald Benjamin Miller after whom the small village of Benmiller was named. He had another son Jonathon Miller who ran the Bedford Hotel in Goderich. Evidently he was a huge man and when he died his casket had to be taken to the cemetery by wagon.

Christeen Haacke (George², Johann¹) was born 8/18 Feb 1845 in Markham, York, Ontario and married **John Wesley Barker** 18 Mar 1868 in Markham. He was born 31 Jul 1842 in Georgina, Ontario and died 01 Feb 1877. They were married by Minister John Mallen of the Christian Denomination (Haacke binder notes). Christeen died 02 Feb 1931 in Toronto, Ontario.

Evidently when her dad died he left her 50 acres of Lot 22, Con. 7 in Markham which she sold in 1902 for \$2,125. The deed was witnessed by John Wesley Barker and Daniel E. Miller.

He was born in 1840 in Markham, York, Ontario and died 30 Apr 1918 in York, Ontario. Caroline died 14 Sep 1879 and was buried in Quantztown Cemetery in Markham.

John had a brother William Lownsborough of Lindsay and a sister Mrs. Stiver of Toronto. He remarried to Lillian Eckhardt of Unionville who had two daughters Maude and Clara (these may not have been his children however). A Lucinda Lownsborough born in Markham died 9 Aug., 1918. Her parents were Hendrick Eckhardt and Diana Penrock. Maybe she married one of John's brothers. From the 1851 Census there was a Thomas

Lownsbrough shoemaker, Church of England, born 1811. Children Thomas 1835, William 1837, John 1839, Sarah 1841 and Hannah 1843.

John was listed as a Painter in the Directory for Brampton 1873-74.

When he died he was listed as John Lownsbrough Newtonbrook which is part of the Don Valley area in Toronto. He was listed as a former resident of Markham having been born in the vicinity of Unionville.

JOHN LOWNSBOROUGH, NEWTONBROOK

A former and respected resident of Markham township, John Lownsbrough, died at his home, Newtonbrook, on April 30th on his 78th birthday. Deceased was born in vicinity of Unionville and with exception of a few years in Huron County, spent his life in Markham and West York. About fifteen years ago he retired from farm life to his late residence at Newtonbrook. His duties as assessor in both these townships brought him into touch with the entire community and he won, through a striking courtesy toward all classes, a very general respect. As a citizen he was deeply interested in all public matters and followed with keen interest the world's progress and struggle. Mr. Lownsbrough had been for many years a faithful and active member of the Methodist Church. About a year ago he was stricken down with paralysis and has since been confined to his home. By his first wife, Caroline Haacke of Markham, two daughters, Mrs. F. W. Hitchlock of Toronto and Mrs. (Rev.) A. J. G. Carscadden of Victoria Harbor, survive. His second wife, Lucinda Eckardt of Unionville, and two daughters, Maude of Toronto and Clara at home, are left to mourn the loss of a devoted husband and affectionate parent. An older brother William of Lindsay, and one sister, Mrs. Stiver of Toronto, also survive. Interment took place at Mount Pleasant cemetery on Thursday afternoon, May 2nd, the service at the family residence being in charge of Rev. P. A.

Sophia Haacke (George², Johann¹) was born 16 Mar 1850 in Markham, York, Ontario and married **William Henry Heise** 25 Dec 1870/1 in Whitchurch Twp., York County, Ontario. He was born 19 Jan 1847 in Markham, York, Ontario. Sophia died 20 Apr 1920 in York County, Ontario (see Figure 01). William and George Heise had a brother Jacob who married Ida Lehman. Two of their children were Nora and Marion both of whom wrote to me with Heise information. Nora told me William had a grist mill in Baldwin and then worked in the post office but by then was not living with Sophia. She said the land for the Christian Church Quantztown Haacke Cemetery was donated by George Haacke. William, Jacob and George were children of Christian Heise and Rachel Brooks (see the family bible at the end of this chapter).

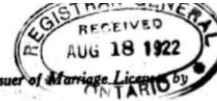
