Part I

This chapter has been divided into four sections because of the immensity of George Haacke's family. Since George and his wife, Sophia Quantz, had 15 children, a single chapter detailing each generation would be incredibly lengthy. This first part about George Haacke's family focuses on the descendants of his son William. The second and third parts will feature the families of George and John David, who both have extensive lineage. The fourth part will include George's daughters and their descendants.

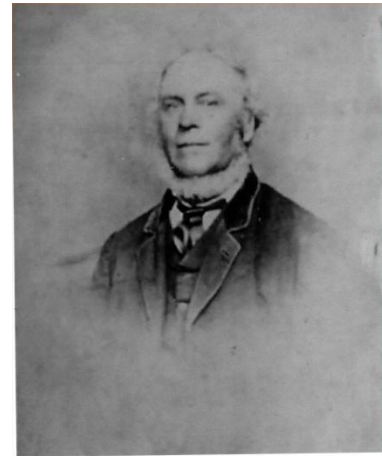

George Haacke

Generation No. 2

George² Haacke was born 15 May 1810 in Markham, York, Ontario, the sixth child of Johann Haacke and Hannah Adams. He was christened alongside his brother Henry (possibly a twin) 12 Feb 1811 at St. James Anglican Church in Toronto. George was married to **Jane Sophia Quantz** 01 May 1837 by David Lunau, the minister of the Wesleyan Methodist Church in Markham. She was born 06 Jul 1817. George and Sophia lived on lot 22 W ½ con. 7, land that George had purchased from J.C.P. Pingle in 1834. They raised fifteen children and a few of their grandchildren in a two-story brick house which George built himself prior to 1871. George made a living as a farmer for most of his life, working a seven day week. George died 21 Mar 1896 in Georgina Township, Ontario and was buried in Quantztown Cemetery in Markham. Sophia was also buried here after her death, which occurred 01 Aug 1892 or 04 Aug 1892 at the 7th Concession, Markham Twp.

George had a lot of transactions on and around lot 22, concession 7, Markham

- 10757 registered May 17, 1834 at 12:30 on the oath of George Pingle between J.C.P. Pingle and George Haacke, for L250, w1/2 lot 22, con. 7. w. George Pingle and Charles M. Keller
- 11298 Nov. 6, 1834 between Henry Haacke Yeomen [George's brother] of the first part and Thomas Robson, Merchant, of Toronto... to his heirs...subject to a certain condition thereunder written that the said indenture should be void on payment of a certain sum of money at the times and in the manner therein mentioned... w. Joseph Ridout and George Cooper George Haacke signed his name in German (i.e., Georg Haacke) reg. Dec. 2, 1834 at 1:00.
- 13446 reg. Dec. 1, 1836 John Bell and J. Eastwood executors of T. Robson certify that G.H. and H.H. have paid their debt in full Nov. 4, 1836. w. R.B. Miller and S.B. Fairbanks.
*Around the year 1868, the booking system of deeds changed. Old York which had included Markham, Toronto, Vaughan, etc. was now split into these different groups, each with their own books.
- 979 reg. June 8, 1871 at 1:00 May 27, 1871 between George and Sophia Haacke and Fred Quantz (Mortgagee, i.e. the person who lends money to the people who use their land as collateral). Fred pays George \$1,000 which is to be paid back in 2½ years, on each May 27 and then on Nov. 27, 1873. G.H. did not have to insure his house. If in default he could lease or sell the land within 90 days, at which time he must pay the extra interest. Sophia bars her dower w. Daniel Quantz and Wm. Nichols. The deal took place in Markham and Daniel says that he knew the Haacke family.
- 1966 Fred Quantz discharges the mortgage and puts his mark on the paper. reg. Nov. 19, 1874 at 11:30 a.m. w. W. Nichols and D. Quantz. An important point here is that Sophia's maiden name was Quantz and she was closely related to these people. Also note it took them a year longer than originally decided to pay him back. This D. Quantz may be the Daniel who kept many family records and who made the statements about George shown earlier.
- 8353 reg. March 30, 1896 4:00 Proceedings in the High Court of Justice between Wm. Heisey and Wm. Haacke Plaintiff. Wm. Haacke calls in question the title or interest of W1\2 lot 21, con. 7 50 a. and W1\2 lot 22, con. 7 100 a., and E1\2 of lot 18, con. 6 dated Toronto, G.M. Lee Clerk of Records and Wills
- 8355 Nov. 12, 1895 to 8361 the following were all w. by Clifford Heise. The second party was always Wm. Heise acting for George Haacke, as a go between for him and his children. These deeds give land to several of his 15 children for the fee of \$1.00 each, under love and consideration. The transfers took place in Georgina Township, in Sutton. It may be said that George was living with the Heises who supposedly had a grist mill in the village of Sutton.

The last Will and Testament of George Haacke

This is the last Will and Testament of one George Haacke of the township of Georgina in the County of York and Province of Ontario Gentleman.

I hereby revoke all former wills and other testamentary dispositions by me at any time heretofore made.

I direct that all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses be paid by executor hereinafter named.

I give and bequeath to my grandchildren Elizabeth Brown (nee Lunau); Daniel Edward Miller; Mina Lounsbrough and Mary Lounsbrough all my personal property which I may die possessed of share and share alike.

I appoint William Heise of the township of Georgina in the County of York Miller Executor of this my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I have set my hand this twelfth day of November A.D. 1895.

Signed published and declared by the said Testator George Haacke and for his mark X last will and testament in the presence George Haacke of us who both present together at the same time at his request and in his presence have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses: Clifford Heise and A. Crozier

This is a codicil to the last will and testament of me George Haacke of the township of Georgina in the County of Georgina made the twelfth day of November in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight-hundred and ninety-five.

I hereby appoint my son John David Haacke of the township of Markham in the County of York Farmer and Daniel Quantz of the same place Gentleman to be executors of my last will and testament and to act with William Heise as if they had been originally appointed with him. In all other respects I confirm my said will. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this nineteenth day of December 1895.

Signed published and declared by the said Testator George Haacke as and for a codicil to his last Will and Testament in the presence of us his mark X who both present together at the George Haacke same time at his request and in his presence have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses.

And so it seems with George Haacke's death it is the end of an era. His father Johann and his mother Hannah now gone and many of even that first generation gone, his children began their own pioneering adventures to the west. John David who was in Markham then also heads out west where Henry's family had ended up, and then William, and now John David going to Port Huron (where many of his family and their descendants still live today). I wonder if John David ended up leaving because he now had the wherewithal to do so after his father's will was resolved.

Other comments about George. He supposedly owned a lot of land over his lifetime. He was a good husband to Sophia (according to William A. Quantz Journal). He would say if you can't work for a dollar work for 50 cents. George was a hard man but he was a good man. George was a very ambitious hard worker. He evidently gave 1 acre of land for the Church Hill Baptist Church. George and Sophia were buried in the Christian Church Cemetery Lot 15-6-M.

From William Quantz's journal directly:

"Sophia married George Haacke. Their home for the greater part of their lives was on Lot 21-7-M. Fourteen children was all they had. My recollection of Aunt Sophy are pleasant ones. She was a hard worker, motherly, sunny-tempered, Christian. Uncle George was a hard man but I believe he was a good husband. Unlike the Quantz's, he was a money-maker, adding form to farm and money to money, nearly all of which has been squandered by the children since his death. They both died near the old home and both lie buried in the old Christian graveyard on the 7th concession where so many of the descendants of the house of Quantz have found their last resting place."

From the assessment rolls of 1853-1862 we find G. Haackee 43, farmer, with two horses and 1 pleasure carriage and 1 dog. He had 50 acres with 35 under cultivation. 1 acre garden, 15 wild. He also had 6 acres of wheat for 112 bushels, 5 acres of peas with 100 bushles, 3 acres of oats with 100 bushels, 0.5 acres of potatoes with 40 bushels. He also had 4 bundles (tons) of hay, 60 pounds of wool, 40 pounds of maple sugar.

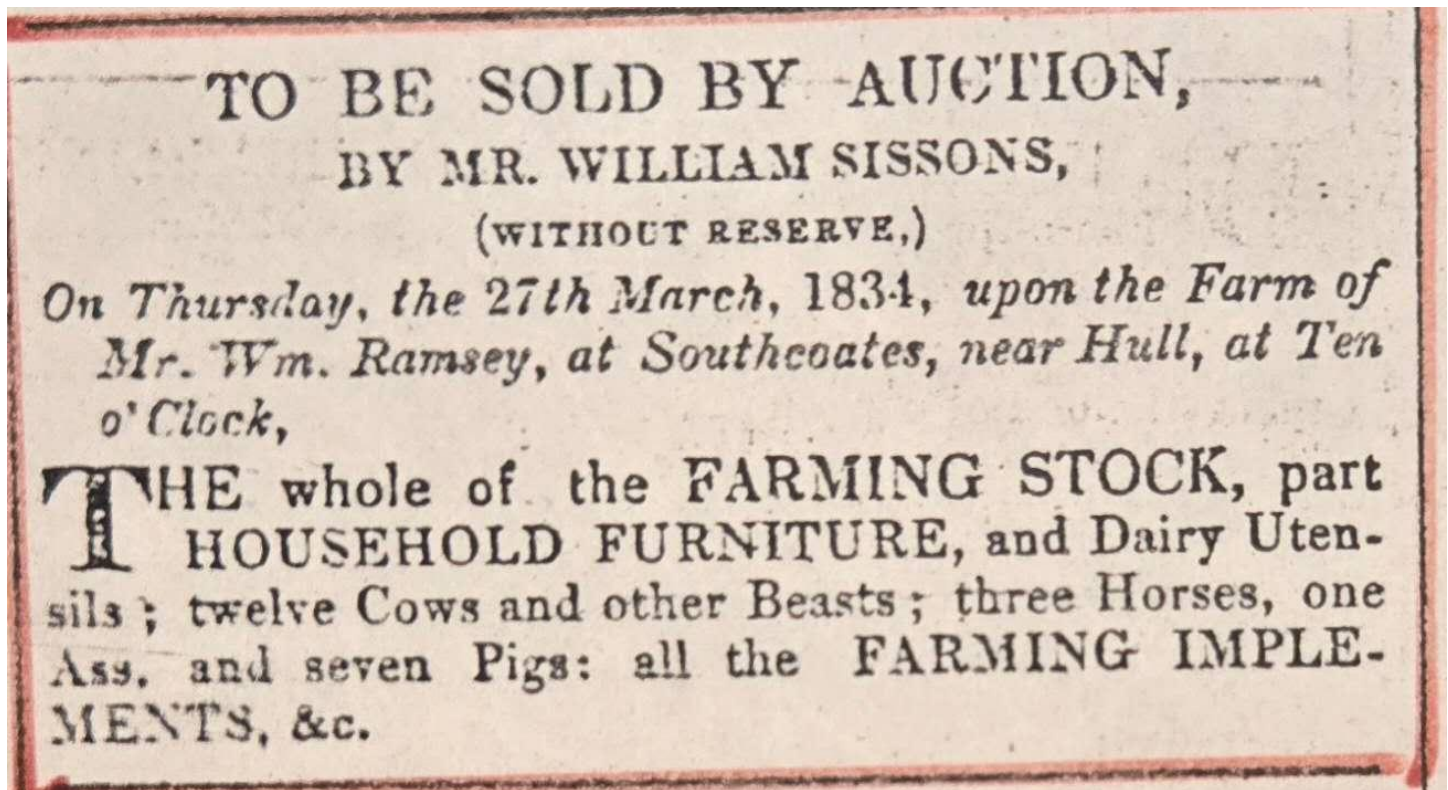

Generation No. 3

William Haacke (George², Johann¹) was born 01 Jul 1841 in Markham Township, York, and died 12 February 1910 in Goderich, Huron County, Ontario. He married **Martha Ramsey** 31 Dec 1863. She was born 17 Jul 1839 in Mariposa, Victoria, Ontario. Her sister, Hannah Annie Ramsey, married William's brother, George Haacke. William spent his life working as a farmer in Markham and Goderich. In Markham, he and his family lived on lot 18, Con. 6 from 1871-1882. His father, George, lived with them during that final year. The 1871 census lists William as a Lutheran and the assessment rolls indicate his land was worth \$2,750. William purchased lots 14-17, Con. B near Goderich in 1885 and played a role in a decision that took place in the High Court of Justice regarding his father's land in 1896. William died 12 Feb 1910 in Goderich, Huron County, Ontario (see appendix figure 02) and Martha died 24 May 1930, also in Goderich. Gerald Walter, the son of Barry Walter and Grace Haacke (one of William's granddaughters and a daughter of Wilmot), still owns the original property in Goderich. Among William's personal property, Barry still retains William's and Martha's favorite rocking chair, some of Martha's English china, and a family bible.

This is the last will and testament of me William Haacke of the township of Goderich in the county of Huron and province of Ontario, made this the 11th day of May in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one.

I revoke all former wills or other testamentary dispositions by me at any time heretofore made and declare this only to be and contain my last will and testament.

I direct all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses to be paid and satisfied by my executors hereinafter named as soon as conveniently made be after my decease.

I give, devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate of which I may die possessed in the manner following, that is to say:-

My wife Martha Haacke is to hold all my real and personal property for her own use during her natural life; after her death I want my real estate sold and divided between my three sons William G. Haacke, Edwin Haacke, Wilmot Haacke, they are to have equal shares.

My wife Martha Haacke is to pay to my two daughters Hannah S. Haacke , Ada Maud Haacke fifty dollars each out of my personal property and the balance is hers to do as she likes with, my insurance policies I want them to stand as they are.

All the residue of my estate not hereinbefore disposed of I give, devise and bequeath unto

And I nominate and appoint Martha Haacke, John McGibbon to be executors of this my last will and testament.

- Her burial took place 26 May 1930 at Maitland, Goderich (section F), Huron County, Ontario.
- Cause of Death: Apoplexy
- One of her sisters, Hannah, married George, one of William's younger brothers.

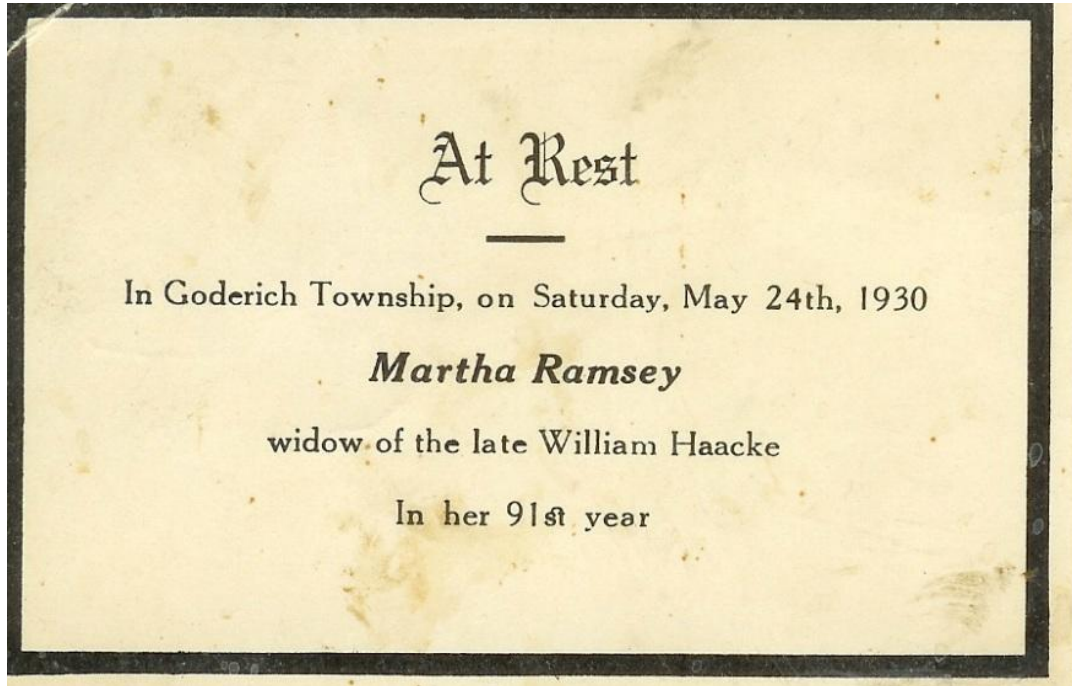


Figure 5: Martha Ramsey funeral card.

Generation No. 4

Hannah Sofia Haacke (William³, George², Johann¹) was born 28 Dec 1864 in Markham, York, Ontario. She married **George Reesor** 31 Jul 1883 in Markham. He was born 12 Sep 1861 in Markham and died 26 Jan 1944 in Toronto, York, Ontario. Hannah died 24 Aug 1937 in Markham. Both Hannah and George were buried in St. Andrew's Cemetery in Markham.

More about George Reesor:

- He farmed the land on which he was born. His was the first brick house in the area, but it was destroyed by fire in the early 1930s

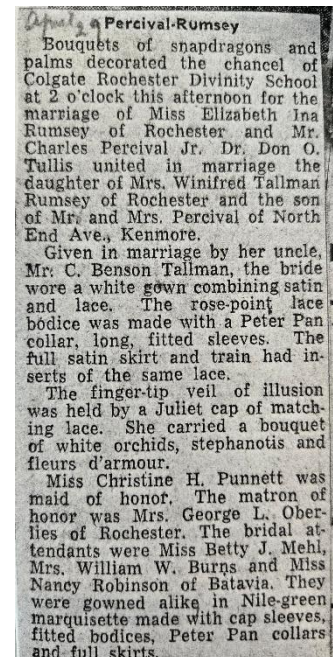

 - Birth Reg. #04797When I first started the family research, I remember calling her and she said it was too long ago that Allen died and that she was too busy taking care of her own mother. Her mother was born 2 May, 1877 and died 11 February, 1970. So when I called her it was probably just before this, so she herself would have been nearly 70. Recently, I found a story about a baseball game at the Duke of Connaught School where Robertson's team won the match with Joe Haacke serving as first base. Thursday, 26 June, 1924. Then another article with a picture this time from Tuesday, 7 October, 1930 states that Bobby Rosenfeld's team, the Maple Leafs, won the senior Toronto championship game in their first season in the senior league.

William George Haacke (William³, George², Johann¹) was born 13 Sep 1866 in Reach Township and married **Alice Mary Maud Fisher** 22 Jul 1890 in Toronto, Ontario. She was born 12 Feb 1874 in Worcestershire, England and died 04 Dec 1938 in Toronto at her daughter Martha's home at 117 Woodfield Road. William worked as a streetcar conductor, driving the no. 67 car on King Street (Anna's notes). He may have lived in Goderich as a teenager, but later made his residence at 53 Morley Avenue in Toronto. He is said to have been religious, going to church every Sunday. He wore a mustache and became bald later in life. William died of a heart attack and subsequent cerebral hemorrhage 09 Jan 1914 in Toronto, York, Ontario (see appendix figure 04). Alice remarried twice before her death on 04 Dec 1938. It is a bit strange that Maud's name appears in William George's will below as Mary Maud Elizabeth which may be a mixup of her name with her mother's name.

This is the Last Will and Testament of me, William George Haacke

Of the City of Toronto in the County of York, Street car Conductor, made this Fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and twelve.

I DIRECT my Executors hereinafter named to pay all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses as soon as conveniently may be done after my decease.

I GIVE, DEVISE AND BEQUEATH unto my dear wife, MARY MAUD ELIZABETH HAACKE, all my real and personal estate of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated for and during the term of her natural life and from and after her decease, I DIRECT my executors to divide my estate equally among my six children, share and share alike.

In case my wife, MARY MAUD ELIZABETH HAACKE, should remarry then it is my will that she should have the use of my house, Number 53 Morley Avenue, Toronto, for and during the term of her natural life subject to payment of the annual taxes thereon but she shall have no further claim upon my said Estate for maintenance or otherwise and the income arising from my Estate shall cease as far as the preceding paragraph is concerned.

I NOMINATE AND APPOINT my wife, MARY MAUD ELIZABETH HAACKE, my brother, WILMOT HAACKE and my friend, JOHN T. WALKER, to be the executors of this my Will at the same time revoking all former and other wills by me at any time heretofore made.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand the day and year first above written.

More about Alice Mary Maud Fisher:

Alice Mary Maud Fisher [2]----- (b 12 Feb., 1872 in Bristol, England, cert.? d 4 Dec., 1938) was the mother of Ada Loie (b 1891, m Charles Brown), Gladys Irene (b 1895, m Charles Percival), William Allen (b 1896, m Mary Josephine Carpenter), George (b 1898, m Winnie Lawson and then Ann Ross), Martha Elizabeth (b 1902 m Adam Craig) and Harry Ross (see 3-4). She remarried three times, the second time to a Mr. Walsh and a third time to a Mr. Stubbs. In 1932, Allen was listed as living at 117 Woodfield Road and working for the Otis-Fensom Elevator Company. In 1927, George also lived there and was a foreman at SMP.

From the Toronto Star, Tuesday December 6, 1938, page 30:

STUBBS, MAUD HAACKE: Suddenly on Sunday evening, December 4th, 1938, at the residence of her daughter, Mrs A. Craig, 117 Woodfield road, Toronto, Maude Haacke Stubbs, beloved wife of the late William Stubbs and dear mother of Ada, Mrs. A. Brown, Toronto; Gladys, Mrs C. Percival, Buffalo; Martha, Mrs. A. Craig, Toronto; Harry Haacke, Deloro Ontario; Allen and George Haacke of Toronto. In her 65th year. Resting at the residence, 117 Woodfield Road, for funeral service on Wednesday at 3 p.m. Interment St. John's cemetery, Norway. Dear Bro and Sister,

I should of answered your letter long ago, but it was so cold this winter, that we did not go to town very often, so I had not written it when they went but I am making a stab at it now. We are all very good but getting old. I will be 81 on June 4th and my wife will be 75 her next birthday. I was out to B.C. for four months. It was a wonderful place to see. I was up on two or three mountains. One was 4000 feet high. We rode a horse back. They all told me that I could not stand the trip but I did and I did not feel any the worse for it. Some places were as steep as the roofs on your barn but these horses are used to it as they walked very slow and stopped to rest if it was too long. We got a big moose right at the top of the mountain. It weighed 500 pounds. Jack tied half of it on each horse to fetch it home. Well it was sad about Tracey but there was two of our neighbours drop dead working and we had lots of murders and suicides out here last summer. We blame the liberal government. We are having a nice spell of weather right now.

We may have an early spring. The last 3 springs was late. We could not seed till May. We have 16 grandchildren and great-grandchildren now and they are all well. We expect Dora from B.C. soon. She has one Grandchild and Bill has one grandson. I have not much more to tell you. I have stopped working much. I worked up till I was 80. I quit the council then too. I was 20 years a councillor. So, I quit the council as the doctor said I was doing too much so I only do chores now and visits. So I will close now. So I will close now, hoping this will find you all well as it leaves us. Write soon. Ed and Louisa [Haacke]

Harry Ross Haacke

1950

The tragic death of Harry R. Haacke at his summer home at Crowe Lake early Friday morning, September 1st, came as a shock to the whole community. He had been in failing health for about four years and his condition had caused a state of melancholy which he was unable to overcome and his sudden death was the result.

Harry Haacke was born in Toronto, a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. George Haacke, he was 57 years of age. His early life was spent in or near that city and in 1915 he enlisted for service in the First World War. He served overseas as a Sergeant in the Army Service Corp.

About 1922 he came to Deloro to assume the management of the Deloro Trading Company Limited store and conducted the business for twenty five years with marked success. His genial and kindly manner made him many friends throughout the community, who will regret his untimely demise.

He took keen interest in community affairs and for a number of years served as a member of the Deloro Public School Board. He was also a director of the Marmora Agricultural Society for some years. The late Harry Haacke was for many years a valued member and elder of St. Andrews United Church. His loyalty to the church and minister, his generous support of its various undertakings and his service as a member of the session were much appreciated. He had been a member of the Marmora Lodge A.F. and A.M. since 1924. About three years ago, he was granted a year's leave of absence by the directors of the Deloro Trading Co. Ltd. owing to ill health, but his condition failed to improve. He retired at the end of the year. In 1948, he and Mrs. Haacke purchased a house in Havelock, where they had since resided with exception of the summer months, which they spent at their home at Crowe Lake.

A funeral service was conducted by Rev. Geo. Young with prayer by Dr. Fletcher of Oshawa, a former Minister of St. Andrews. The Masonic Funeral Service was conducted by Wor. Bro. C.R. Whittemore, W.M. of Marmora Lodge. Several other members of the Marmora Lodge also attended together with a number from Toronto and other places. Interment took place in Pine Hill Cemetery, Toronto on Tuesday.

The late Mr. Haacke is survived by his wife, formerly Anna Fidler; one daughter Mrs. William Kerr (Dorothy), of Toronto; and two sons, Harry R. of Norwood and Ewart of Toronto; also ten grandchildren. He is survived also by one brother George Haacke of Toronto, and three sisters, Mrs. Ada Brown and Mrs. Martha Craig, both of Toronto, and Mrs. Gladys Percival, of Kenmore, New York.

A short funeral service was conducted at the summer house at Crowe Lake on Sunday afternoon by Rev. Geo. D. Young, B.A., B.D., after which the remains were conveyed to the Funeral Chapel of McDougall and Brown, Danforth Ave Toronto

Harry Ross Haacke, whose World War I picture introduces with a gentle smile the Haacke family website, was our grandfather (Mark Haacke) and great-grandfather (Angela Haacke Wildfong). To our knowledge he was just that, a kind gentle man who enjoyed people, a relaxing evening down at the foot of the hill at Crowe Lake on a dual seater wooden swing under the branches of a nearby tree, in the quiet of a summer evening.

Harry Ross Haacke (b 7 April, 1893 in Toronto, d 1 Sept. 1950) lived in Toronto until 1922, working for H.P. Eckard Company. He served in the R.C.A.S.C. in World War I for 3 years. He moved to Deloro and ran the Deloro Trading general store until his death in 1950. In 1924, he bought land on Crowe Lake; his wife Anna called it Idlewild. The land was bought from Anna in 1956 by their son Ewart and his wife Helena and in part by his other son, Harry Ross Jr. In 1978, Ewart and Helena sold their portion to their son Mark and his first wife Linda. Later, around 1982, Harry Ross Jr. sold his portion to Mark and Linda.

Harry apparently had an aptitude for arithmetic, as this was the only subject he got an 'A' in on one of his public school report cards. He enjoyed building and being with people. He was a gentle man, but not without a temper. Harry was a delightful man and contributed a great deal to the local scene in Deloro. He was very active in Church, School and Masonic activities. Mark Haacke still has two of his Freemasonry books. He used to run the extensive July 1 celebration, with races, games and fireworks.

Although this next piece is rather personal, it reminds us that the people we are researching had feelings as much as we do today and the study of their lives should encompass this part as well. Part of a love letter from Harry to Anna before the first World War follows.

Cure for Lovesickness to be taken moderately and whenever required

Dr. Cupid

My Dear Little Sweetheart:

Once again I take up my pen to write you sweet words of Love. Oh Darling, you don't know how much you mean to me and how deep my love is for you. I sit and think of the nice Loving times we have had together and think of the times when once again I shall hold my darling in my arms and hug and kiss and touch her where and when I like. Maybe you will think I am silly, but Darling my love for you is so deep that you are constantly in my thoughts....

Now Ladybird, I do want you to have a good time while I am away, but sweetheart don't forget I am very jealous....Darling you know I am only human and the thought of you being so true sure helps me forgo temptation.

Now my Shining Star, the one precious Jewel in this world, I am going to close....

From one who thinks all the world of you,

Your ever Faithful Friend

He married Anna 4 August 1912 in the House of Rev. Hallman of Berlin (Kitchener). He had brown eyes, a medium build, brown hair, and was about 179 cm tall.

Evidently, toward the end of his life, Harry suffered from something. It is not clear if it was from depression, from some other disease that affected him, or what. In any case, he killed himself in 1950. One wonders if with modern medicine today, these problems might not have been avoided. His obituary hints at some of his community involvement and activities during his life in Deloro.

Memories of Bristol: Fact or Fantasy?

My grandfather, Harry Ross Haacke, died before I was born. He had fought in World War I and seen his sons enlist for World War II. Anna Rittenhouse Fidler, my grandmother, lived with us in the summer at our cottage on Crowe Lake near Marmora, Ontario, Canada. She was a keeper of interesting tidbits, both for physical items such as stamps, newspaper articles and other general interest items as well as family memorabilia such as photos and a record/address book. This 5"x8" one inch thick address book (herein after referred to as the blue book) contained wedding announcements, poems, pictures, and was replete with names and dates of events for family members: I did not know many of the names therein. Little did I know that three special entries in that book along with two or three photos hiding in one of a dozen photo albums, would lead me to Bristol, England.

The brunt of my early schooling in genealogical research was on my father's family who had settled in Toronto prior to 1800. As I traced his line back, I was lucky enough to find out something about the wives' families too. Unfortunately, I had little to go on about Harry's mother, Alice Mary Maud Fisher and Anna was no longer alive in 1976 to help me pursue this avenue. However, my father, Ewart Mortimer Haacke, remembered some visitors to the cottage (evidently the summer time was ideal for inviting far away relatives to come together again) an artist, George Benson, and an elderly lady Mrs. Russell. One photo also showed her at the cottage, with the note in the back reading just, "grandma Russell". How was Fisher related to Russell? Both of these people were from New York City. Some time later I discovered a card from my father to my mother from New York during some training during the world war. He said he was taking some time to visit his "Aunt Bess", but the best he could do for a last name was Slater. Finally, the blue book had some help, it listed, "Bess Schulter from Phoenix died 1948". At last something concrete to go on.

Also during the early research, I discovered a picture taken by Henry during the first world war in Bristol of a cousin, Edith. Edith E. Lewis

Once again, the blue book helped, a lady by the name of Daisy Palmer was listed with a Bristol area address. I took a chance that there might still be someone there 30 years later. In 1979, I received an answer from the present tenant who knew of the people of whom I was inquiring (he was the second person after Daisy Palmer died to live there) and gave me the address of an Isabel Couzens. Somehow, she was related to grandma Russell. All I had so far was a vague outline of potential family structure.

The next step (1976) was to acquire the marriage certificate of Maud Fisher and George Haacke. Luckily the Ontario Registrar's office had this record and her father was listed as Henry Fisher. In 1977, the president of a research firm in England, Kenneth Gowie, contacted me. In 1978, they found that Alice Mary Fisher was born 20th Feb., 1872 to Henry Fisher and Emma Burnell. The blue book helped here in giving a birth date close to this for Maud and it also listed Elizabeth Russell born 1848. Searching further, in 1979, they found the marriage certificates for Henry Fisher and Elisabeth Emma Burnell. They married July 28, 1862 while she was still in a minor. Henry was a hatter as was his father George while Elisabeth's dad, Richard, was a coachman. Both families lived on Victoria Street. The witnesses were Richard Burnell and Mary Jane Burnell; progress was being made. More on this family in the Burnell document.

More about Anna Rittenhouse Fidler:

(b 23 Sept., 1892 in Coopersberg, Pa., d 28 Jan., 1967). She lived in Coopersberg, Pa until 1900 when her family took her and another sister to stay with the Hall? family in Berlin, while her parents went to Hadjin, Turkey. Anna was active in the Girl Guides and became a district commissioner. Later, she became involved in the Eastern Star and rose to the highest office. She enjoyed playing bridge and keeping family notes and picture albums. She inherited her mother's problem of balding and passed this on to her daughter Dorothy. Her children were Dorothy Aileen (b 1913, m William Kerr), Harry Ross (b 1915, m Norma Bullied) and Ewart Mortimer (b 1920, m Helena Doris Davies). She was brown eyed, of small build, had dark brown hair, and was about 168 cm tall. She was buried 1 Feb., 1967.

George Haacke (William George⁴, William³, George², Johann¹) was born 08 Aug 1898 in Ontario. He married **(1) Ann Ross**. She died 21 Jun 1964. He later married **(2) Winnifred Lilian Lawson** 25 Dec 1919 in Toronto, Ontario. She was born in 1902 in Walsall, Stafford, England. George died 14 Jun 1956.

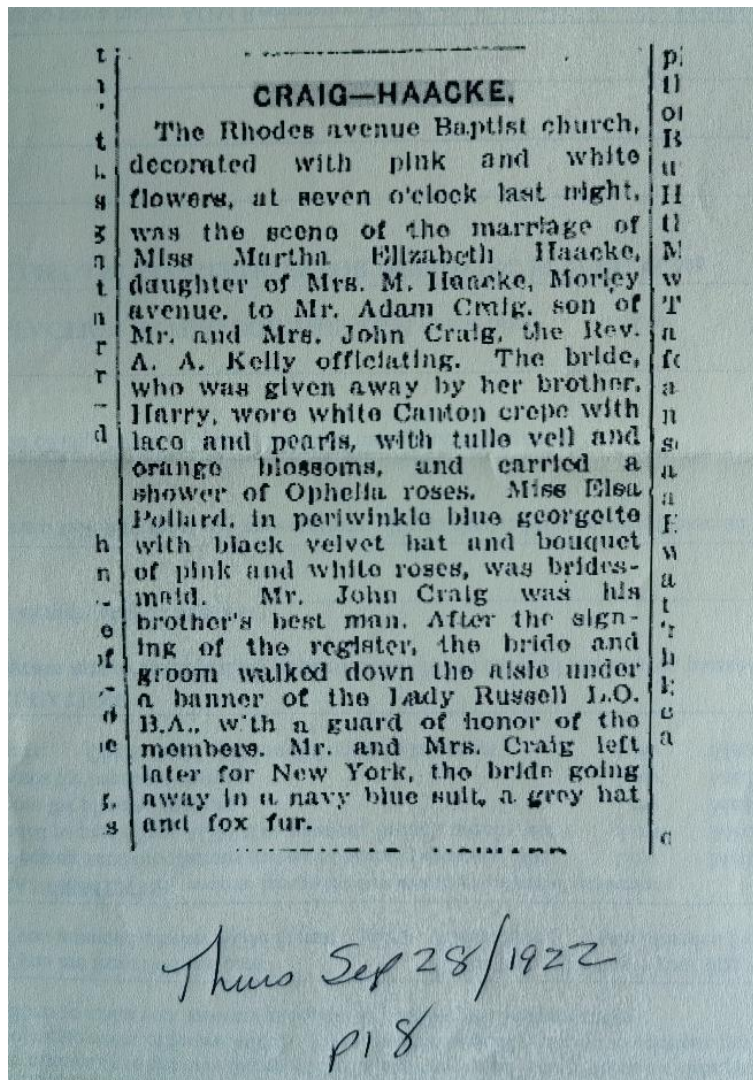

More about Ewart Mortimer Haacke: Ewart Mortimer Haacke (b 12 October 1920 in Toronto m. 21 March, 1942) moved to Deloro, Ontario in 1922. He attended public school in Deloro, high school in Marmora (where he earned the McDowel scholarship in physics at Queen's University in his senior year) At the age of 17, he went to attend Queen's University in Kingston. He graduated from Queen's University at Kingston in 1942 as an electrical engineer. He first worked for Bell Telephone and then served three years in the R.C.A.F. during WWII. During the war, he served as a radar officer, then a special sonar bombing officer, graduating later with his Navigator's Wings. He also taught at the radar school in Clinton Ontario. In 1943, he went to New York City for a several week training course at Sperry Gyroscope. While there, he visited an Uncle Ed in Brooklyn who took him to see Laguardia Airport. Dad also thinks another cousin, possibly George Benson (or Fisher), lived in New York City and was an artist for a newspaper there.

In 1939, at a dance in Havelock, he met Helena Doris Davies, his future bride. The story goes that there was an earthquake then and that threw my mom and dad into each other's arms. From that moment, it was fate they fell in love and got married.

His interests included golf, but now are travel, bridge, and reading for pleasure and business. He is 180 cm tall, had a medium build, is hazel eyed and has black hair. During his childhood, he had diphtheria and when he was 15, he had jaundice for several months. Presently, he has a mild form of sarcoidosis, perhaps partially due to the fact that he worked in the mines when he was a teenager. This disease affects his lungs. Several accident related incidents have occurred to him during his life. As a youngster, he was snow sledding and hit a post and another time ran into a large truck with heavy chains on the tires (he was five then) The injuries he sustained to his head and face completely healed. Another time he was scheduled to leave in a plane during WW!!, but his meeting prevented him from catching the flight. The plane blew up on the runway. Once while skating on Lake Milo, the ice broke and he nearly drowned. At Crowe Lake one summer, he landed head first into shallow water and hit a rock while skiing into shore. He ripped open the side of his head. Mom and her sister and husband helped hum up the hill and quickly rushed him to the hospital where he received 17 stitches. Later, a serious infection occurred and great care in removing the infection from the head was required. He was bedridden for several months. Another time he ran over his toes with a lawnmower and cut up several toes which luckily healed.

In 1937, he represented the school district at the coronation of King George VI and wrote a series of articles for the Marmora Herald Newspaper. One article of this series called "Notes From the Diary of Ewart Haacke" is summarized below.

4 a.m. The rising bell woke us and we scrambled up ready to go.

4:30 Breakfast.

5:30 We assembled in groups of 8 and marched to our stands to watch the procession. The Canadian girls were already there and gave us quite a hand.

7:30 After a long wait some of the palace guards appeared.

8:40 The Lord Mayor of London left the palace, followed by the speakers of the House of Commons, and the Prime Ministers of all the Dominions and Colonies, soldiers of all countries, carriages with celebrities, and then the Golden Carriage. We all rose to our feet and shouted as the coach went up the mall carrying our King and Queen.

11:00 We had lunch.

12:00 We wandered around St. James Park while the coronation service was being broadcast.

2:30 We watched the Grenadier Guards marching in front of the palace.

3:30 Went back to the stands for the returning procession.

3:50 Perfectly parading soldiers marched by. Our whole stand gave the Mounties a tremendous cheer. The rain started, but the procession was as dazzling as ever. Then a little bit later, the King and family came out on the balcony. I was ready with my Feild glasses and had a good view of the family. All the while the crowd was cheering with delight.

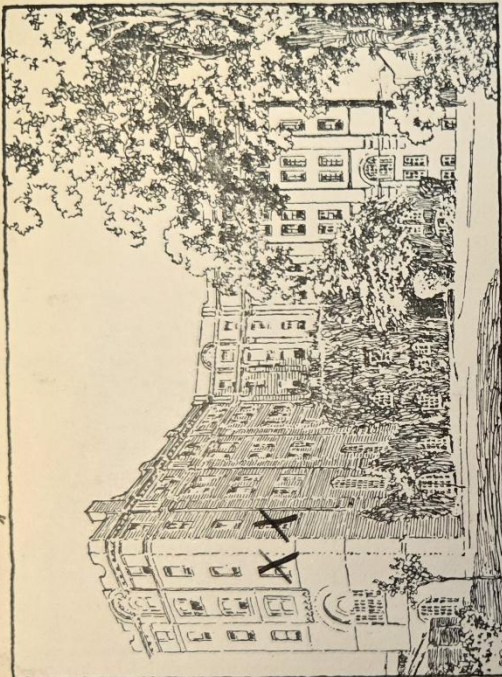
May 22

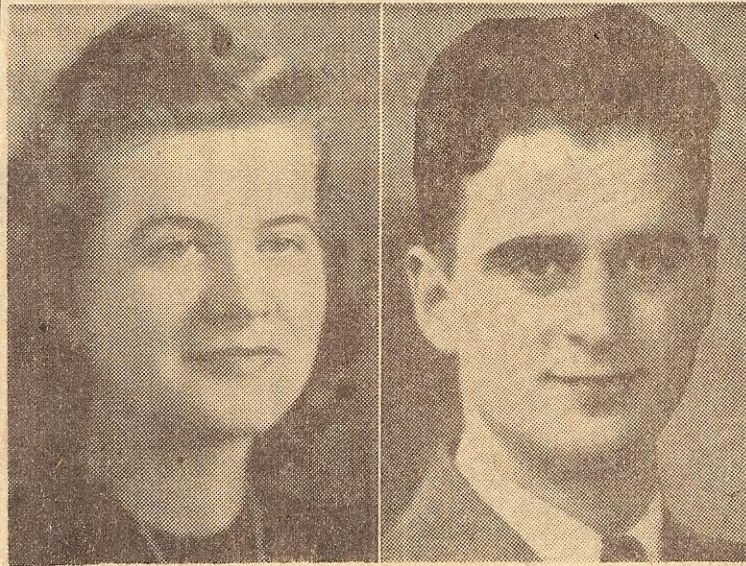

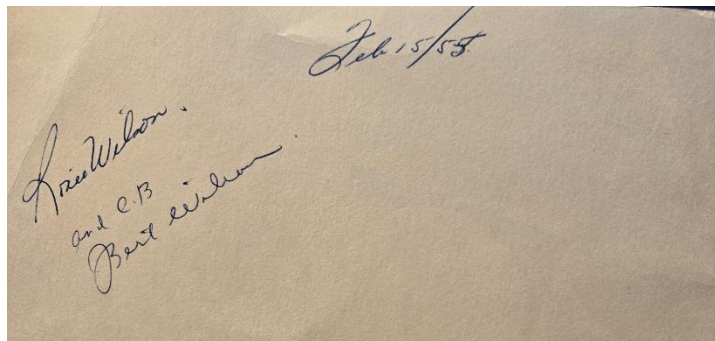

12 March, 1943: Sent from Henry Hudson Hotel, 353 West 57th Street, New York

Hiya, honey, darling,

Another two grand letters from my darling today. Gee! I'm lucky. Be at home Saturday night on the five something train if nothing happens in the meantime. We haven't made our trip to the airport yet. That will take two days or so – but hope to have it over by Thursday afternoon when we leave here. Being back as soon as Saturday, I'm pretty sure we'll be able to get the high allowance per day, so don't worry your pretty little head over it. How did your date go the other night? It was funny that when you told me where you thought I might be going you didn't ask me if I miss talking to you, having you near me and having you all for my own when we are alone and in love (which is always). Sorry if it sounded as if I was picking a fight by letter, wasn't it awful? I'm feeling blue without you honey cause I love you and want to come home and hold you in my arms, hug you and do the damdest to make you happy. Don't get me wrong honey, I am glad you went to the show, it was a good idea and fair, but I can't help that green eyed monster in me. Remind me to tell you of the night we went to Morocco. Gee honey there are so many things to tell you. "I love every bit of you, now and for always." How's Brian doing to-day. Kicking much? I'm sure anxious to feel him moving around. It's wonderful to think of you have a little one of yours and mine. I love you, I love you, I love you, I love you. Careful of that Lieutenant next door. I'm jealous as hell. Thanks for the money order.

They were so thrilled to be having a baby, and obviously had chosen Brian as his name. However, Brian it was not to be, as Sharon was born 10 August, 1943.

Dad worked at Noranda Mines, Quebec, in the summer of 1939.

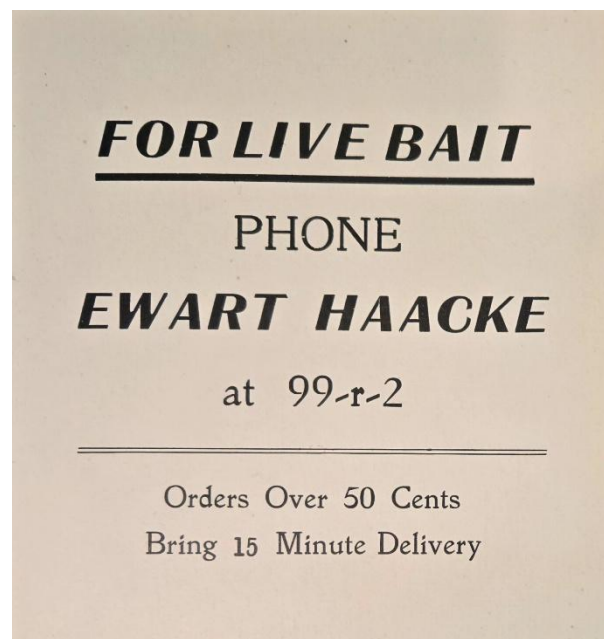
- 1) Worked with Archie Mallory on started for sump pump and hanging cables.
- 2) Worked with Henry Heath at the Concentrator. Changed the switch on the bin feeder. Restocked the fuse cabinet and checked elevator starter. Removed old motors and fixed push button switch on #8 pump.
- 3) 2 May, 1939: I was Tom Burwash's helper. Worked on slag pot controllers, worked in the slag tunnel. Then worked under Cottrell and installed a switch in #1 sample mill. Changed bearings on the motor in the cyanide plant. Cleaned the anode wheel controller. Rode #4 crane.
- 4) Worked in cone switch room on Ball Mill Feed Lines. Checked time relays in the cone switch room. Installed double voltage interlock conveyors.
- 5) Worked with Wally Brown pulling cables through conduit in concrete floor. Connected cable from #2 turbine to the control panel. Worked next with Jerry Merchant, the lone wolf. Put gutterbox behind the graphic meter panel in the power house. Put a thermocouple meter on #2 turbine. Metered the C&D boiler fans. Worked in the power house metering new lines. Assisted in the removal of #1 turbine from base.

Dad went on to become an electrical engineer. This experience must have given him a lot of exposure in dealing with many things electrical and mechanical.

Ewart's Bait Shop.

When dad was young he had a large cylindrical frog container. By the time I came along and was about 10, it was pretty badly rusted but I used it for a while too to keep frogs. Dad showed me how to catch worms in the late night or early morning when the dew was on the ground and the sun wasn't up yet. I think he must have done that until he was about 18 years old, earning extra money for school. Why do I say this? Well, there is a letter from the Toronto Star. Editorial Department, written 30 June, 1938 to dad. It starts,

"Dear Sir: You can get soft-shelled and hard shelled crabs from Skinner's Bait Shop, Yonge St. Arcade Toronto. They tell us that the sogt-shelled ones are important. The Department of Game and Fisheries, Parliament Building, Toronto will likely be able to give you an article about raising crabs. We have no information about propagating crayfish, but they are raised in ponds. The eggs hatch in March and the crabs are best bait when they are two to three inches long. Yours truly, Questions and Answers."




Dad was a member of the rotary for a long time and therefore was able to go to the Rotary Club. He took me a few times with him when I was young and all I remember is the good food.

LAST WEEK - December 5th 

One of our members, Ewart Haacke, a graduate of Queen's University, Kingston, in Electrical Engineering, gave us a talk and film presentation on the subject of "Lighting and Health".

Mr. Haacke served for three years in the R.C.A.F. and was employed by Bell Telephone, he was the editor of Electrical News and Engineering, and General Sales Manager, J.A. Wilson Lighting, then he set up his own company, Enoh Sales and Manufacturing. He is now employed part-time as Technical Sales Consultant, Duro-Test Lamps, in Rexdale.

He has been a member of Toronto Rotary Club (down town) and is now a member of Toronto-Islington Rotary Club.

Ewart talked about the environmental affects of natural sunlight on humans, for hundreds of thousands of years and some poor results of too much indoor living without the benefit of sunlight. He cited examples of short life cycles in early England, for example, of living without life-giving sunlight. A bit of ultra-violet is important!

He explained that in the last decade or so, a fluorescent lamp has been invented, described as full-spectrum, or balanced spectrum lighting. This has been used in therapeutic applications and helps humans (as well as reptiles in zoos, plants, etc.) to obtain benefit of a light almost identical in colour break-down to sunlight. It helps the body systems absorb calcium, improves workability and see-ability, along with other beneficial effects. A 20 minute N.B.C.T.V. interview was shown.



A matching bulb, shaped like an incandescent, but actually fluorescent, with 17 watts replacing incandescent 60 watts, was available also, he explained during the after-talk question period this almost matched the Vito-Lite output.

Ron Wayman thanked Mr. Haacke for an "enlightening talk."

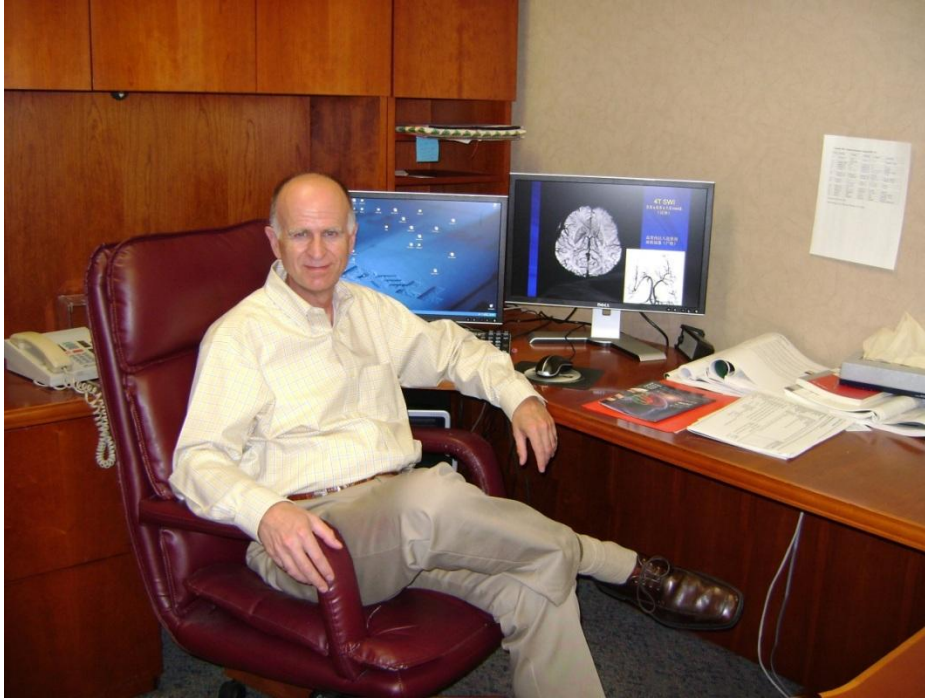


Figure 28: Dr. Ewart Mark Haacke conducting MRI research:

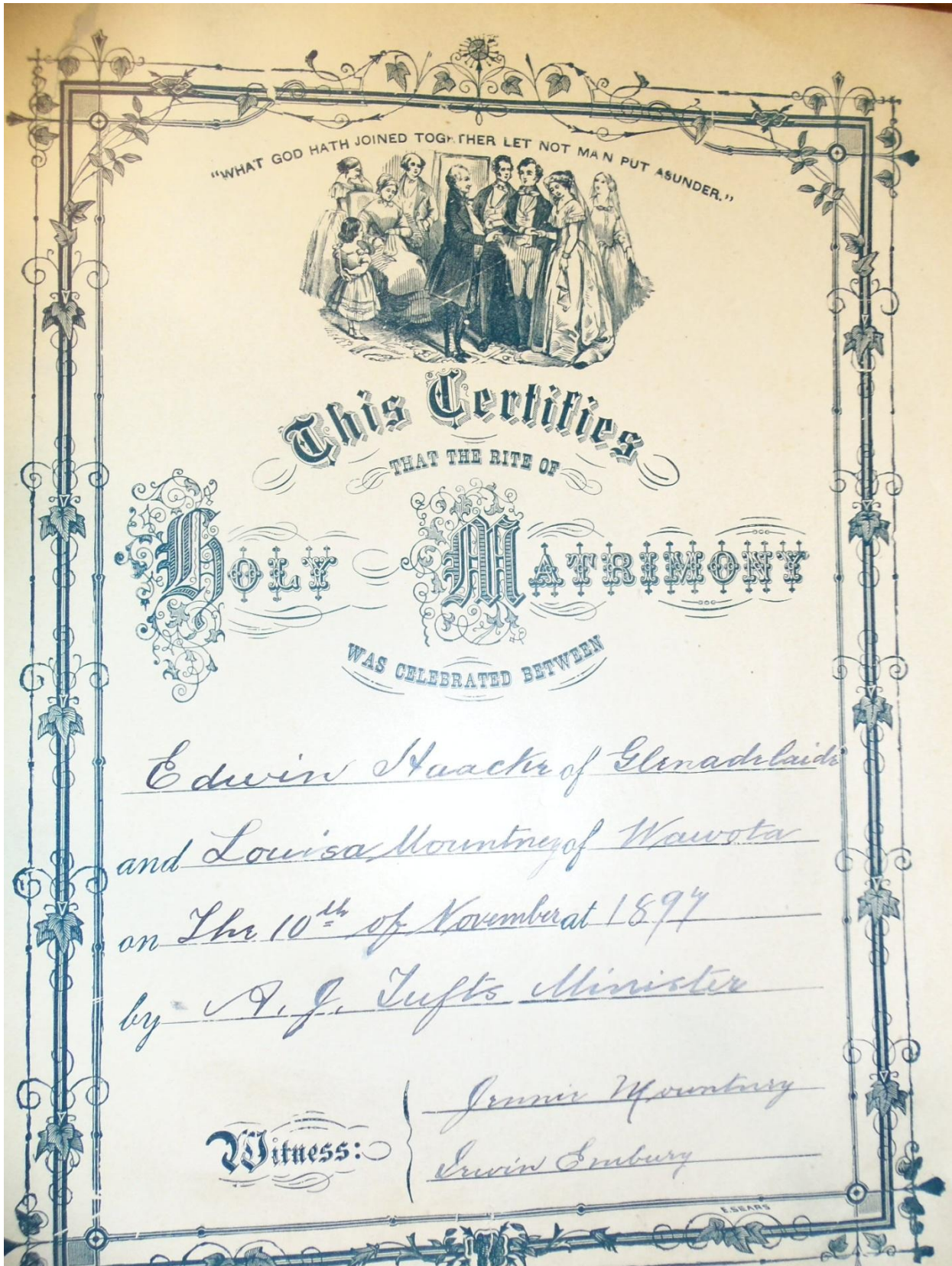


Figure 05: Marriage Record for Edwin Stanley Haacke and Louisa MOUNTNEY

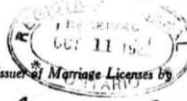

EXCERPTS FROM THE MARRIAGE ACT.

2. (1) The Provincial Secretary shall from time to time, on application made to him according to forms prescribed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, or to the like effect, which application may be made by the applicant or, on his behalf, by the ecclesiastical authority or authorities of the church, religious denomination or congregation to which he belongs, register such person as authorized to solemnize marriage and may issue one or more certificates of such registration to any person so registered or otherwise and may include therein the name of any number of persons so registered.

18. If any person not registered with and certified by the Provincial Secretary, as hereinbefore provided, solemnizes or undertakes to solemnize any marriage, he shall incur a penalty of \$500, and shall also be liable to imprisonment for any term not exceeding twelve months, but such penalties shall be recoverable or imposed only by action at the suit of the Crown.
